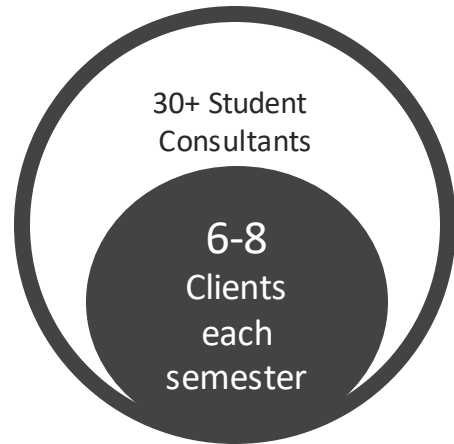

- 2 Support**

Ensure guidance and support for consultants throughout the whole project
- 3 Collaboration**

Use their expertise in the area to work together with the team and help them reach their goals and improve deliverables

## To be considered

- NSC encourages the consultants to have the meetings with you and/or the client organized in advance.
- Mentors are not expected to be part of the consultant-client meetings. However, the club encourages the mentors to help consultants to prepare the meeting with the client as well as to encourage proactivity in the consultants.



The availability of the mentor should be of around 2 hours a week to support the consultants for 8 weeks (from Feb-May)

# Club's Responsibilities

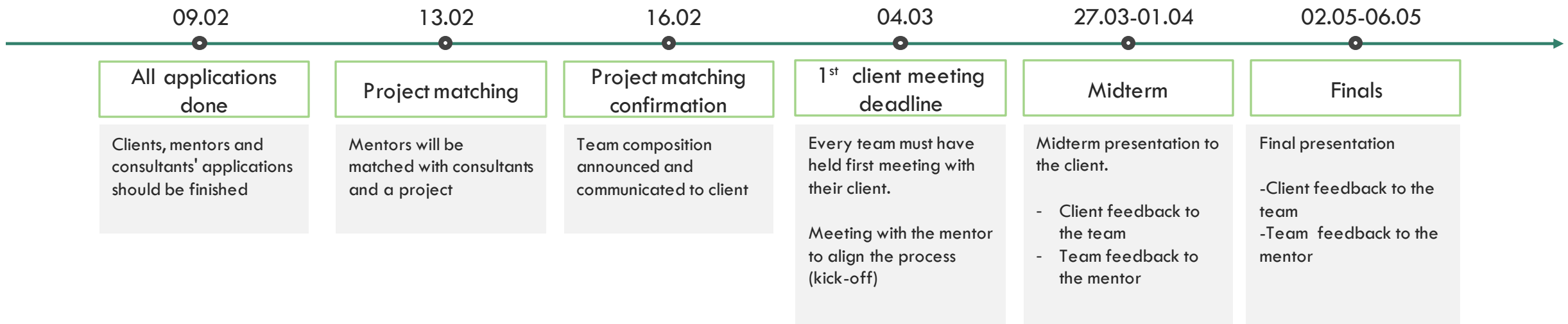
## - From the Board

- Guarantee the first contact with the team members
- Send you feedback about your performance (midterm and final feedback)
- Assistance when needed
- Clarify all the doubts the mentor may have regarding the processes and functioning of the Club/Projects

## - From the Consulting Team

- Team Leader is responsible for scheduling the meetings with the mentor
- The consultants will respect the time and schedule of the mentors
- The team is responsible to share all the necessary information for the mentors to understand the project
